




# Microsoft Teams App

This article describes how to set up integration between More Service and Microsoft Teams

1	Open Microsoft Teams on your PC
2	<div>Click "Apps"</div> <div></div>
3	<div>Seach for "Incoming Webhook"</div> <div></div>
4	<div>Click "Incoming Webhook" in the search result.</div> <div>Then click "Add to a team".</div> <div></div>

5 Input the team name to add the integration to, then click "Set up a connector"



**Select a channel to start using Incoming Webhook**

Incoming Webhook will be available for the entire team, but you can start using it in the channel you choose.

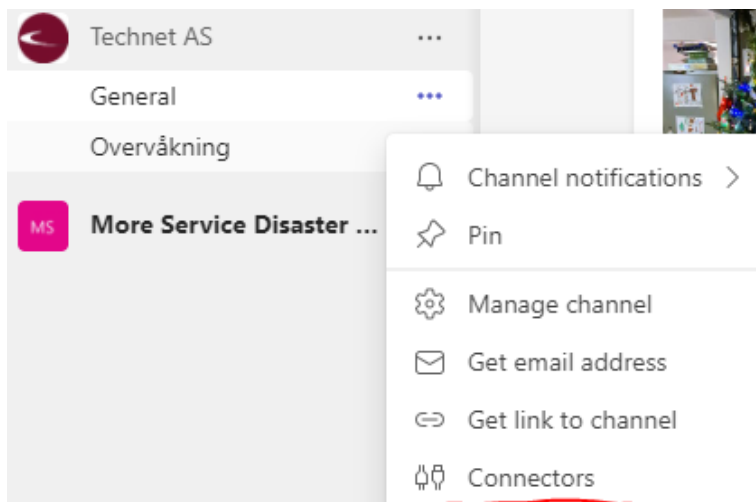

7 Click "Configure". If you dont have it click "Add" and follow the following procedures unit you can configure.





Send data from a service to your Office 365 group in real time.

6	<p>Give the Webhook a fitting name and click "Create"</p> 
9	<p>A new URL has been generated. Copy it and click "Done"</p> 
10	Open your More Service Agent Portal
11	Open Moreservice
12	Go to "Settings" (Cogwheel in the upper right corner) "Apps" "Configure"
13	Click "Microsoft Teams"
	
14	Paste the URL into "Webhook URL"
15	Click "Test connection"
16	If the test is successful, click "Save"
17	New cases that arrive to More Service, are now relayed to Microsoft Teams.
